

CV Softball Field Notes

Below is a list of items that should be in the box/shed:

- Liner
- Bucket of Field Chalk
- String (for base lines) 8' string (circle)
- 2 screw drivers/ stakes
- Hammer
- Rake
- Bases
- Tape measure
- Pitching rubber*

*Please note when setting the pitching rubber use screwdriver/stake to start holes for pitching rubber. This will make it much easier to install.

If you find any of these items is missing or broken please let me know so they can be replaced soon as possible.

If you notice the filed chalk is getting low please let me know so it can re-stocked. There will always be an extra bucket at PW 1 and Creekview as a backup.

To keep boxes organized:


- keep tools mentioned above in bucket
- bases not thrown on top of other equipment (filed liner) or directly inside of shed
- If girls are putting bases away have them take bases to the box/shed **and you or another coach place in the box/ shed**
- We as coaches are ultimately responsible for putting equipment away and keeping boxes/sheds organized.

After each practice/Game the following field maintenance should be done:

- Pitcher's mound filled in and raked
- Batters boxes filled in and raked
- 6' area around mound, home plate and bases
- Base removed and plugs replaced
- Pitching rubber removed
- Trash and removed from bench area
- Items replaced in box/shed in orderly fashion

Key measurements:

- Tip of home plate to 1st & 3rd base post – 59' 4" and 7" in from foul line
- Tip of home plate 2nd base post – 84'10"
- Pitching circle 16' diameter
- 6U & 8u – 30' front of rubber to back of plate
- 10U – 35' front of rubber to back of plate
- 12U – 40' front of rubber to back of plate
- 14U – 43' front of rubber to back of plate
- Batters box – 3' x 7' and 6" inches off of the plate (see image below)
